Herman Melville Notes

• Wrote in 1840's – 1860's after a tough life

revival of fame in 1920's

- Friendship w/ Hawthorne
- *Moby Dick* 1851

Conferred epic dignity on sailors.

Saw injustice while sailing (whaler).

Wrote "Bartleby the Scrivener."

Themes

- Believed in evil in the universe
 - injustice
 - cruelty
- Quest for knowledge
 - raised philosophical questions
 - no final certainty of knowledge possible
 - If people try to "know" they will destroy themselves.

Style:

- Combines realism + symbolism
- Skepticism
